This is _____. I will be serving as net control for the Tellico Lake Amateur Radio Club weekly net, which will begin in approximately 1 minute. If there are any stations with emergency or priority traffic, please call now before the net begins.

I am now calling the Tellico Lake Amateur Radio Club net to order on the WB4BSC repeater, located in Tellico Village, at 442.100 with a pl of 100 and a plus 5 megahertz offset. The back-up repeater, should one be necessary, is 444.250 with a pl of 127.3 and a plus 5 megahertz offset.

This net is held every Wednesday evening at 19:00 local time, unless there's a scheduled in-person club meeting or the net falls on a holiday.

The primary purpose of this net is to practice net protocol and to provide the opportunity for amateur radio operators to exchange traffic and radio-related news, information, and opinions. All amateurs are welcome to this net, and you do not need to be a member of TLARC to participate. This is a directed net, so please address all transmissions to net control, unless instructed otherwise.

Are there any news or announcements for the net, please call now.
